

A LETTER from Pastor Andy

Welcome to summer. As I type this on the dining room table in my house, the temperature is 56 degrees. How's that for May 27th. But I know that the weather will change. Change is inevitable, isn't it? And there are many times when we don't care for change very much.

Well, change is coming to First UMC – West Plains. And we may not like it, but it is coming. The change I'm referring to is the appointment change of our Associate Pastor, Scotty Wall. You may already be aware of it, but if you're not Bishop Bob Farr and the Cabinet of the Missouri Conference of the United Methodist Church has appointed Scotty to be the Campus Pastor of Central Methodist University in Fayette, MO, which is just outside of Columbia.


